OFFSHORE PETROLEUM AND GREENHOUSE GAS STORAGE ACT 2006

PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO A SAFETY ZONE

I, William Lee Tinapple, the Executive Director Petroleum and Environment Division of the Department of Mines and Petroleum pursuant to section 616 of the *Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006*, hereby prohibit all vessels other than vessels under control of the registered holders of Production Licence WA-33-L and vessels operated by authorised persons who are exercising powers under section 615(1) of Division 1 of Part 6.6 of the above Act from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing of the Executive Director, Petroleum and Environment Division (Designated Authority).

This safety zone extends to a distance of five hundred (500) metres from—

- The Blacktip Wellhead Platform (latitude $-13^{\circ} 53' 41.58''$ South, longitude $128^{\circ} 29' 2.81''$ East.*); and
- The Blacktip Pipeline Spool Bend (latitude $-13^{\circ} 53' 37.17''$ South, longitude $128^{\circ} 29' 4.70''$ East.*)

*note: the above are GDA94 coordinates

The Safety Zone remains in force for the duration of the operational activities.

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 616 of the Act and are punishable, upon conviction, by a imprisonment for a term—

- not exceeding 15 years if the breach is determined as intentional.
- not exceeding 12.5 years if the breach is determined as recklessness.
- not exceeding 10 years if the breach is determined as negligence.
- not exceeding 5 years if the breach is determined as an offence of strict liability.
