

Fatalities on offshore drilling facility, Bass Strait, 27 August 2012

The National Offshore Petroleum Safety and Environmental Management Authority (NOPSEMA) has commenced an independent investigation into two fatalities on the Stena Clyde mobile offshore drilling facility on the morning of 27 August 2012. The workers were fatally injured during drilling operations being carried out by Stena Drilling (Australia) Pty Ltd on a well in the Otway Basin in the Bass Strait.

The Authority is unable to provide further information on the incident at this stage.
