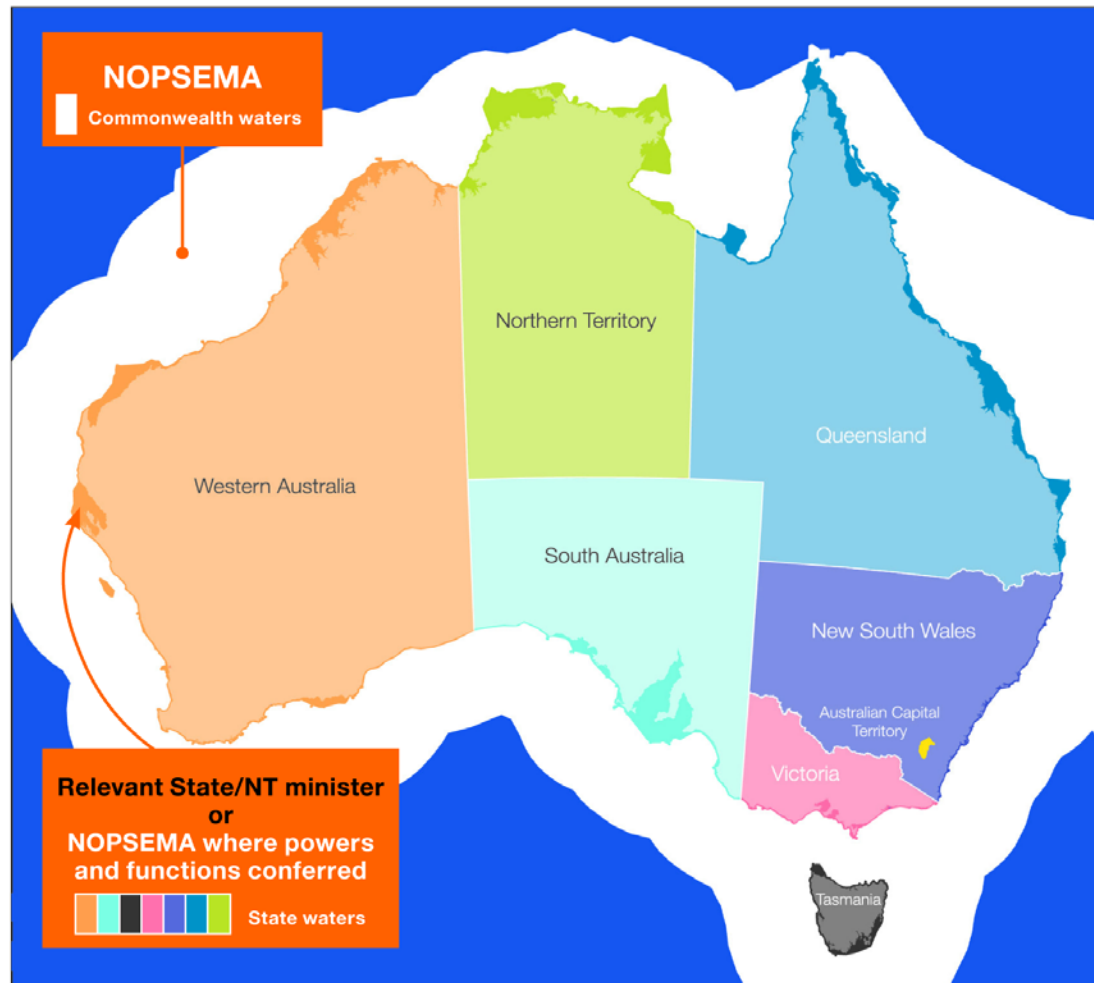

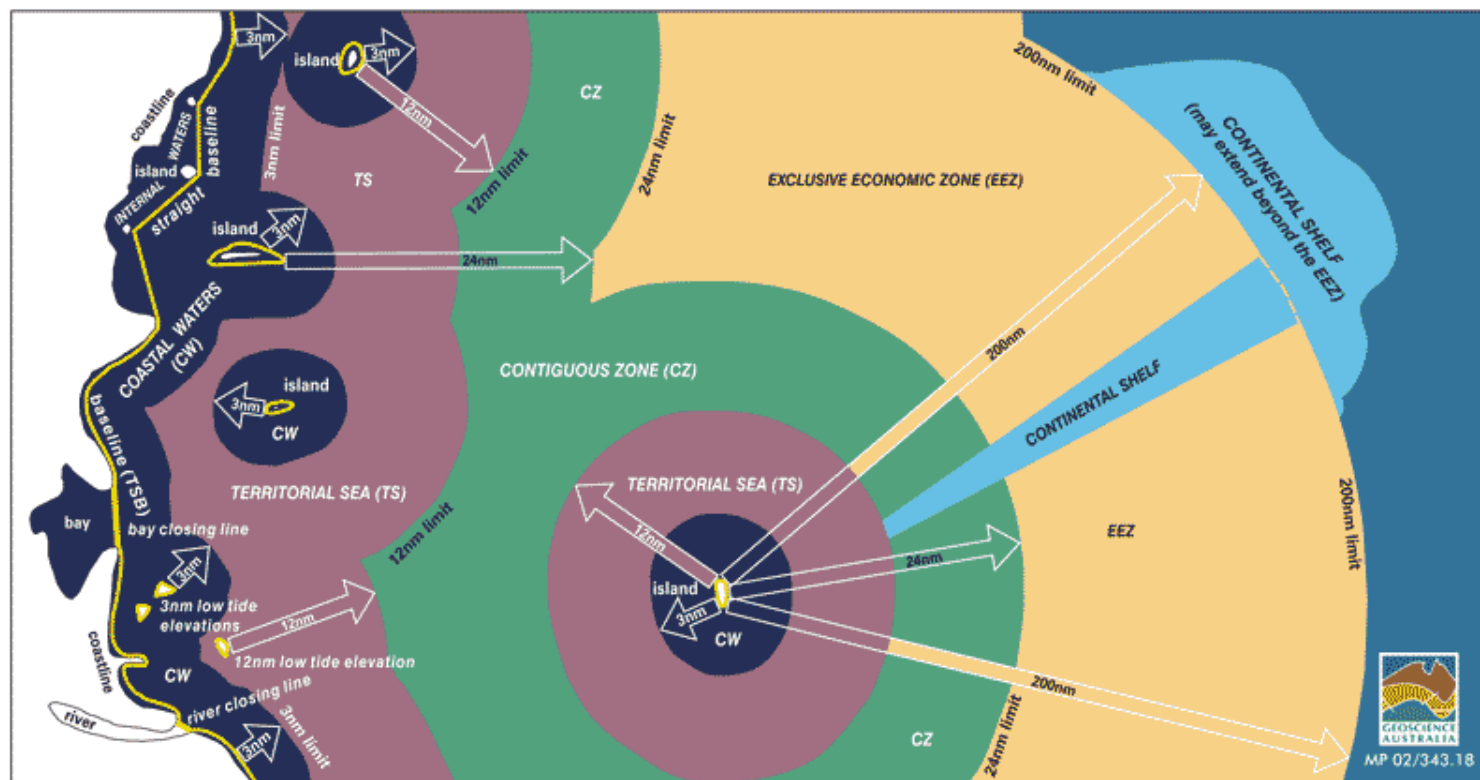

Jurisdiction of the single national regulator for offshore petroleum OHS and environmental management



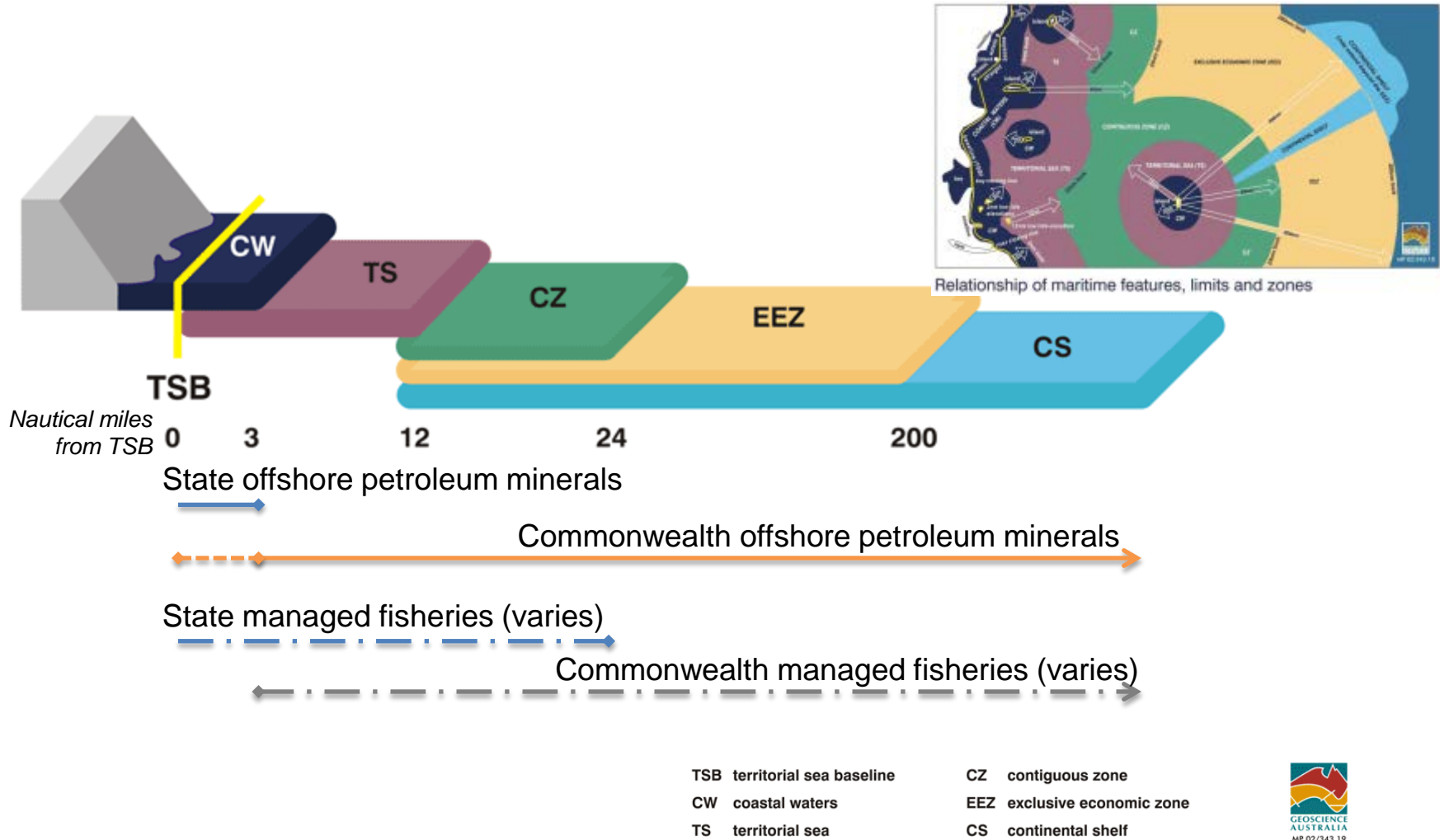

- Social licence v Regulatory licence
