Subject: Start of Activity Notification 10 Day - Minerva Decommissioning and Field Management Environment Plan Commonwealth and State

Dear Stakeholder

Woodside advises that it will soon be undertaking decommissioning activities as part of the Minerva Decommissioning Project (Offshore Petroleum Production Licence VIC/L22 and Pipeline Licence VIC/PL33). The decommissioning activities will be undertaken in Commonwealth and State waters.

Commonwealth waters activities shall be in 57 m water depth, 6 km south of Port Campbell. Activities will be carried out in accordance with the *Woodside Minerva Decommissioning and Field Management Environment Plan – Commonwealth*.

State waters activities will be undertaken from the horizontal direction drill exit site, located approximately 800 m from shore in 20 m water depth, to the 3 nm State waters limit of in 60 m water depth (a total length of approximately 4.756 km). Activities will be carried out in accordance with the *Woodside Minerva Decommissioning and Field Management Environment Plan - State*.

The decommissioning activities are expected to commence around 23 December 2024 for 90-120 days. Work will be undertaken using the Subsea 7 operated vessel Seven Sisters.

Woodside is providing you notification as per the Performance Standards of the Environment Plans.
