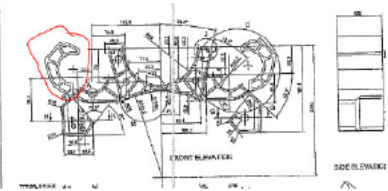

Brief Description of Event			
Whilst the vessel was dredging in the vicinity of KP9, it was observed a white plastic saddle less than 100mm x 100mm floating on the port side of the vessel. Initial assessments were that the item became dislodged during the dredging activities, however it is unknown if it was due to the dredging equipment making contact with the plastic buddle or from the water pressure of the dredger. The item quickly floated away from the vessel and it was deemed not reasonably practicable to recover safely.			
  			
Immediate Actions Taken			
Remind personnel to report any marine debris or foreign objects so appropriate actions can be taken. Procure telescope poles with nets as a recovery technique if this occurs again on the provision it is safe to do so and within reach.
