Notification and Reporting of Accidents and Dangerous Occurrences

An initial report of an incident was recently submitted to NOPSEMA by Woodside Energy Limited relating to an incident that occurred on the CWLH OKHA FPSO on 18th November 2011. A notification of this incident should have been made to NOPSEMA as soon as practicable after this incident occurred. The submission of the initial report to NOPSEMA does not fulfil the requirement under the Regulations for the Operator to notify NOPSEMA of an incident as soon as practicable.

For your information, NOPSEMA must be notified by offshore facility operators about incidents that have occurred at those facilities. The requirement to notify incidents is established by clause 82 of Schedule 3 to the *Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006*, which states that the operator must give the Safety Authority notice of and a report about any:

- Accident that causes the death of, or serious personal injury to, any person, or
- Accident that causes a member of the workforce to be incapacitated from performing work for the period prescribed, or
- A dangerous occurrence, as defined in the regulations.

Operators should note that there is a requirement to both 'notify' and 'report'. Regulation 2.42 of the Offshore Petroleum (Safety) Regulations 2009 states that the notification must be provided as soon as practicable. In practice notifications are most commonly made by a telephone call to the NOPSEMA incident notification number (08) 6461 7090.
