- B4 - no change.
- B5 - no change.
- B6 - no change.
- B8 - Apologies, this should have been in the TC pack.
- B10 - no change.
- B11 - no change.
- B12 - three entirely new maps have been added (088, 089, 090) and others changed highlighted in RED in the table of contents. Old maps not provided.

- C1 - entirely new document, merger of parts of the old F1, the old C1 and old A3, which made track changes illegible.
- C2 - entirely new updated appendices embedded within document.
- F5 - no change.
- G4/G5 - The old G5 was the Otway Adjustment Protocol. This document is now G4 with no other changes.

On B7 (a & b), our copy of the document uploaded has both reports contained within the attachment. I will upload this again today through the submission portal along with the tracked change version of B8.

Hi ██████

With reference to the various appendices that CGG has resubmitted as part of the Regia MSS EP, and with reference to the cover letter that accompanied the resubmission, we have a few points that we would appreciate you clarifying please. I don't want the assessment team to make assumptions about these and then find we aren't reviewing the correct version.

1. There are a number of appendices that only appear in the clean version of the appendices, not in the tracked version (A1, B2, B6, B8, B10, B11, B12, B4, B5, F5, G5, C1, C2). For each of these, please can you clarify the reason, e.g. does it mean the appendices haven't had any changes made to them, or changes were so significant that it was impractical to track them (and therefore only provided the clean copies), or if there is another reason for this?
2. Appendix B7a and B7b (sound modelling reports) haven't been provided in either the clean or the tracked version of the resubmitted appendices. Please can you provide these?
3. The old G4 (Sea Country Protection Program) appendix doesn't appear in the appendices, nor is it mentioned in Table 1 of the EP. Your cover letter also does not

mention it as one of the appendices that has been removed and incorporated elsewhere.  
Please can you clarify the situation with this one?
