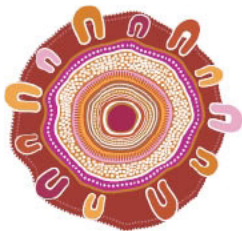

North West Shelf (NWS) Project Extension (EPBC 2018/8335) – update and next steps

- North West Shelf Project Extension has been approved. DCCEEW has received a number of FOI's that will be sent through to Woodside for third party consultation. The final decision will be handed over to post approvals.
- DCCEEW is in the process of handing the project over to post approvals. Once this is complete, the Post Approvals section will contact Woodside to inform them of their obligations under the EPBC Act and provide new departmental contacts relevant to the post approval stage.

- The NWS Project Extension was approved on 12 September 2025, and will therefore be removed from this agenda going forward.

Browse Carbon Capture and Storage Project (EPBC 2024/10028) – update and next steps

- DCCEEW is awaiting internal advice and will follow up with Woodside once this advice is received.

Browse to North West Shelf Development (EPBC 2018/8319) – update and next steps

- DCCEEW have received draft advice from NOPSEMA regarding the Turtle Management Plan and Pygmy Blue Whale Management Plan and are continuing to work through the advice, and will let Woodside know if they have further information requests about the plans.
- DCCEEW has been meeting with EPA and NOPSEMA about the turtle advice.
- DCCEEW, DWER and NOPSEMA will continue to work in a coordinated approach on the assessment going forward.
