- Make a decision under section 29 of the Act, and in accordance with the Freedom of Information Charges Regulations, to impose, reduce or not impose a charge;
- Agree to, or refuse, a request for the amendment of records under sections 50, 51 and 51B of the Act;
- Transfer, or not transfer, a request under sections 16 and 51C of the Act;
- Review a decision of the type mentioned in sub-sections 54(1) and 54A(1) of the Act and to make a fresh decision in accordance with sub-section 54C(2) of the Act; and
- Make a decision of the type mentioned in sub-section 54B(2) of the Act to allow extra time under that sub-sections for an applicant to request a review of a decision referred to in sub-sections 54(1) and 54A(1) of the Act.
