Thank you for your letter, dated 6 February 2026, inviting me to update the nomination of a public official from a Victorian Government department in the event of an oil pollution emergency.

As the Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) is the control agency for marine pollution emergencies in Victorian coastal waters, it is appropriate that the Secretary of DTP continues to be Victoria's designated public official for the purposes of section 33A of the *Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006* (Cth).

The Secretary of DTP's functions and powers relating to marine pollution emergencies may be delegated. As such, the Executive Director, Resilience and Emergency Coordination will be NOPSEMA's primary point of contact in the event of an oil pollution emergency that may impact Victorian coastal waters or land.
