

# Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage (Safety) Regulations 2024

#### New work, health and safety regulations



The revised safety regulations and the amendments to the Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006 are now in effect.

- A review of Australia's offshore safety regime, conducted by the Department of Industry, Science and Resources (DISR), identified improvements that could help strengthen and enhance offshore worker safety outcomes
  - Offshore oil and gas safety review | Department of Industry Science and Resources
- Changes are wide ranging including improvements within broad themes:

Strengthening the role of HRSs

Workforce health and wellbeing

Sexual harassment and psychosocial health

Modernising regulation of diving

Mandatory Design Notification Scheme

Vessel Activity Notification Scheme

Administration of safety cases

Operators and titleholders (proposed operator)

Contact information

Compliance and enforcement

Remedial directions

Miscellaneous improvements

#### Now What?



#### Implementation of the regulatory changes

- Role of NOPSEMA
  - NOPSEMA Compliance Strategy
  - Education and promotion
  - Assessment, Compliance Monitoring, Enforcement
- Role of regulated community
  - "the responsibility for identifying, mitigating and minimising risk (resides with) those wishing to undertake the offshore energy activities – the ones who are creating the risks"
  - Achieve and maintain compliance with the regulatory regime

#### **Previous Information sessions:**



- 18 March 2025: Safety Cases, Safety Critical Systems, HSRs
  - Clarification of technical and other control measures
  - Safety Case revisions
  - Notifications of Dangerous occurrences
  - Prevention and reporting of sexual harassment, bullying and harassment
  - Strengthened role of HSRs (training, safety management related documents, HSR registers
- 15 April 2025: DNS, VANS
  - Early engagement with NOPSEMA during the design phase of a project
  - Set regulatory boundaries within which to assess design concepts and demonstrate that the proposed design for a facility reduces safety risks to ALARP
  - Duty to notify when a vessel becomes a facility or AOP and when a vessel ceases to be a facility or AOP
- 20 May 2025: Notifications and Reporting
  - Changed reporting requirements (sexual harassment, bullying, harassment)
  - New Monthly Operational Activities Report (replaces previous form Deaths of Injuries monthly summary)
  - Revised 3 and 30 day report (combines safety, environment and well integrity)

#### Further key messages:



- Safety Case Content
- All safety cases (new and revisions) under NOPSEMA assessment on and after 12 June 2025 will be assessed against the safety case content requirements in the 2024 Regulations
- Online guidance has been updated to capture the requirements in the 2024 Regulations
