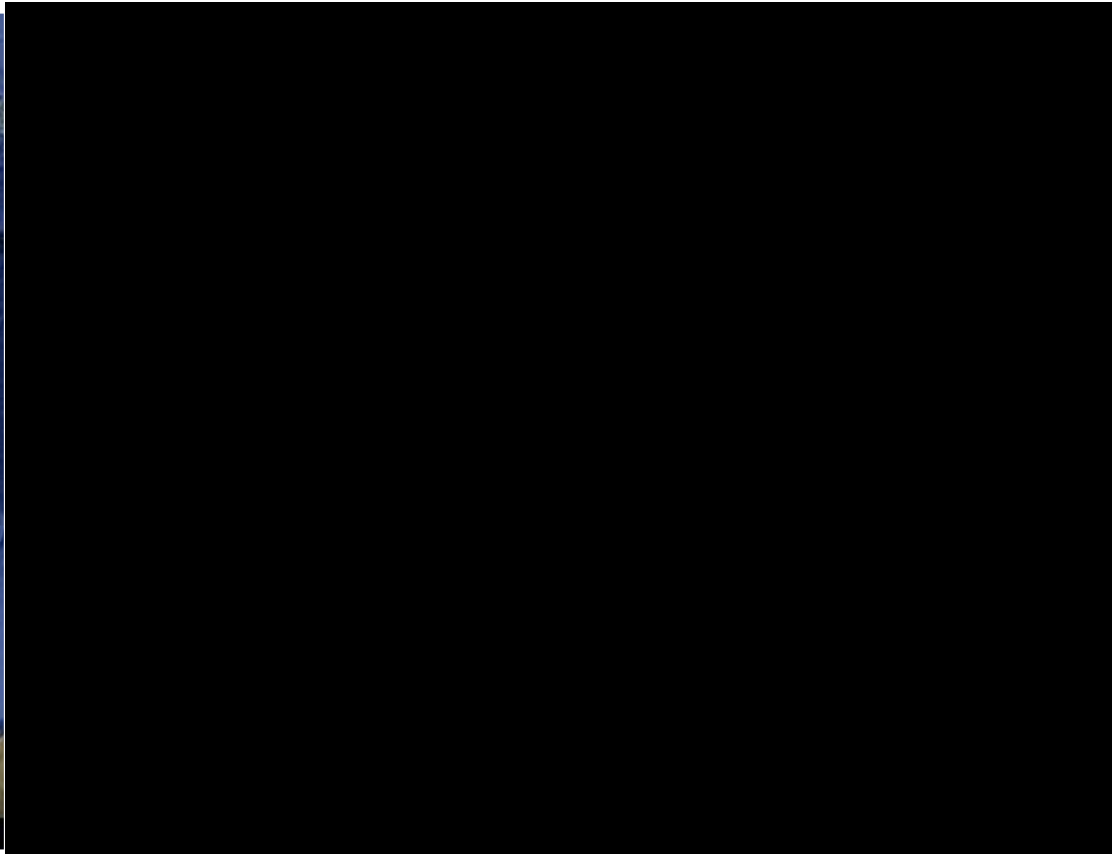
1. 1/12/23: The article is about not being met by the Greens and Labor in Canberra when they wanted to voice their support to the Barossa project.

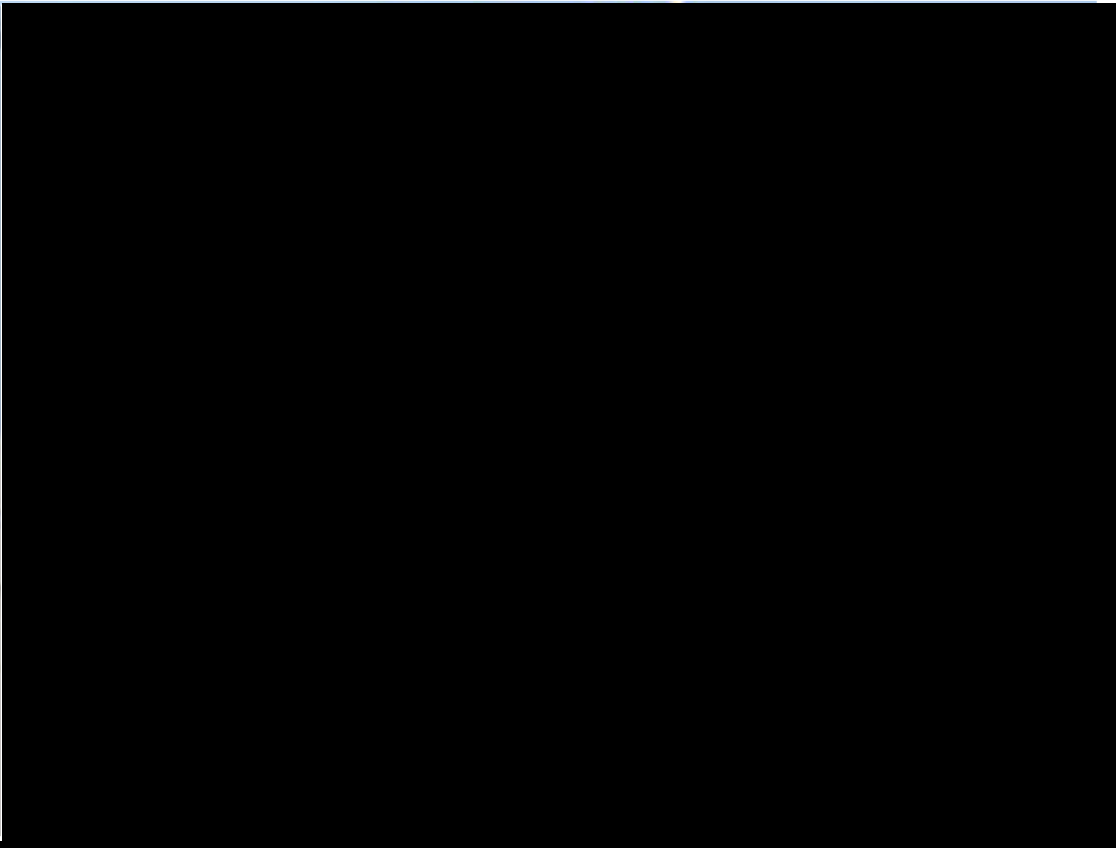

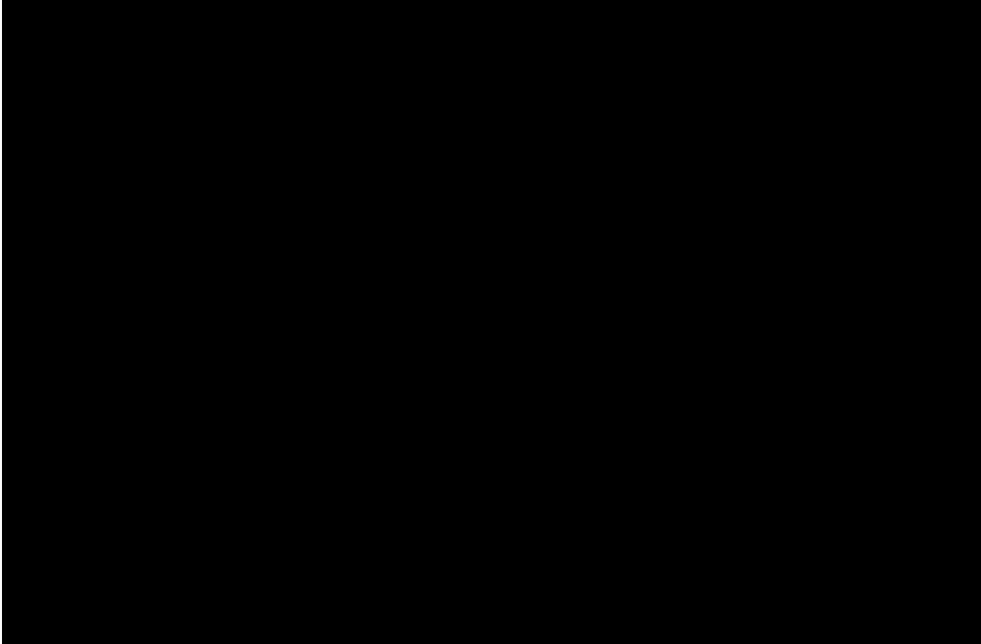

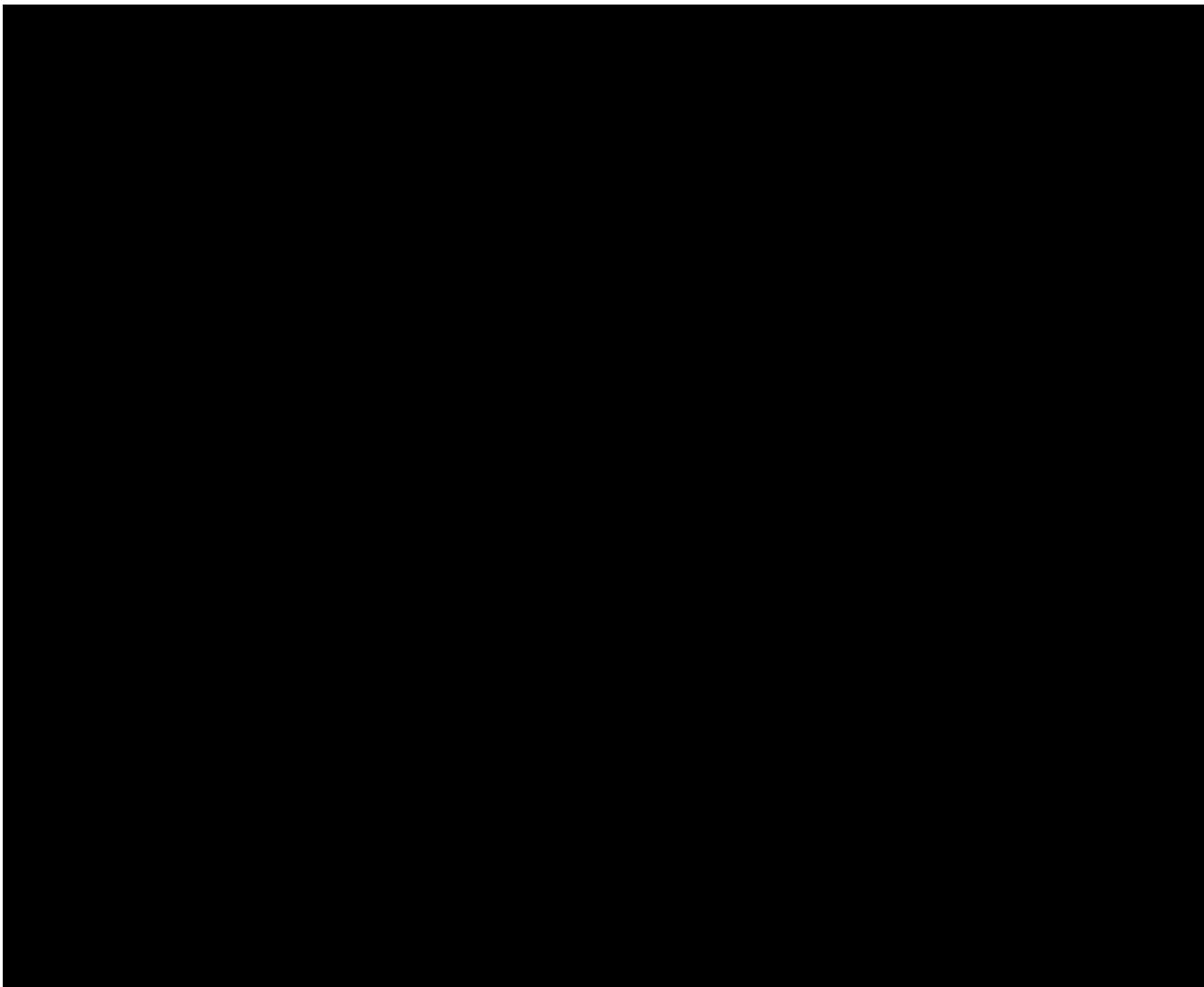
